Public Governance: Innovative government for modernity, efficiency, and effectiveness in the context of globalization

10 November 2022

Background

Since its launch in 2005, the Public Governance Programme of the OECD Korea Policy Centre has been providing capacity-building assistance to the countries in the Asia-Pacific region through its Capacity Building Programme (CBP). Since 2019, the CBP has benefited from the close collaboration between the KPC and the OECD Digital Government and Data Unit, Public Governance Directorate (GOV) as an effort to advance the digital transformation of public sectors in different regions, including South-East Asia, in line with OECD best practices, standards and principles.

In 2021, the Public Governance Programme successfully implemented the OECD Digital Government workshop with the National Academy of Public Administration, Viet Nam, inviting more than 90 Vietnamese public officials. The same year, the two organisations also carried out the Training of trainers event which was for building capacity and skillsets of NAPA trainers.

Objective

In 2022, the Public Governance Programme is delighted to implement a capacity building programme in partnership with the National Academy of Public Administration, Viet Nam with extensive experience and knowledge of public officials training. This year's programme will focus on strengthening knowledge and skills among public officials in Viet Nam in the area of public governance and innovative government.

Topics

Each of the sessions will be based on presentations. These will be combined with discussions around real practical examples. This will give participants the opportunity to raise questions and consider possible responses to problems encountered in their daily practice. The aim of the event is to discuss issues in the public governance and innovative government in the context of globalisation.

Form

The programme will be organised virtually in the form of a video meeting. This will be interactive and engaging, including presentations, discussions and Q&A, and therefore participants will need a stable internet connection to participate effectively.

Interpretation

Consecutive interpretation will be provided in Korean and Vietnamese.
