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## **Background**

Since its launch in 2005, the Public Governance Programme of the OECD Korea Policy Centre has been providing capacity-building assistance to the countries in the Asia-Pacific region. Extending its expertise, in 2021, the Programme is delighted to implement a new training programme “Training of Trainers” as a joint effort with the Local Government Officials Development Institute of Korea, which has extensive experience and knowledge in the field of public officials training. The first pilot will be organised in partnership with the National Academy of Public Administration, Vietnam to build capacity and skillsets of NAPA trainers.

## **Objective**

The “Train the trainers” programme will strengthen the training capacity of the National Academy of Public Administration by creating and supporting a highly skilled network of trainers who will effectively localise and multiply the acquired knowledge and skills domestically.

## **Topics**

Each of the sessions will be based on lectures. These will be combined with discussions around real cases and practical examples. This will give participants the opportunity to raise questions and consider possible responses to problems encountered in their daily practice. The aim of the event is to introduce the blended learning programmes which can be operated online and offline as well as to share knowledge in developing online training contents for local public officials.

## **Form**

The training programme will be organised virtually in the form of a video meeting. The training will be interactive and engaging, including presentations, discussions and cases review, and therefore participants will need a stable internet connection to participate effectively.
